

This is going to benefit from 2-4 years of bottle age and will keep for a couple of decades or more in cool cellars."

This is classic, powerful Rasteau that's going to benefit from 1- 3 years of bottle age and evolve for a decade. It's beautifully done."

" A step up, with more depth and density, the 2018 Rasteau Argiles Bleues is a blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah that was brought up in foudre. Incredibly pure notes of cassis, black raspberries, new leather, chocolate, and graphite give way to a full-bodied, structured Rasteau that has all the right components, yet will benefit from a year or two of bottle age. It will last for a decade or more. It's a seriously impressive 2018."

"The Demeter-certified 2019 Cotes du Rhone is a 70-30 blend of Grenache and Syrah. Scents of black cherries and garrigue emerge on the nose, while the palate is full-bodied, supple and spicy.
