Tightly wound, with ample structure holding the impressive core of blueberry, fig compote and macerated black currant fruit at bay. Lots of graohite, mocha and mineral notes extend the finish. This should be impressive when it opens up fully. Best from 2009 through 2013. 50 cases imported.—*J.M*

Côtes du Rhône Villages Rasteau 2006 \$23

This is really silky, with a core of juicy plum, blueberry and fig fruit surrounded by sweet spice, incense and melted licorice notes. The finish is long and pure. Drink now through 2010. 450 cases imported —*J.M.*
