



**95** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Châteauneuf du Pape Boisrenard 2007* \$85

Ripe, with lush crème de cassis and crushed plum fruit, showing excellent focus and drive, with racy acidity and taut, licorice-tinged structure. Turns flashy and exotic on the finish, with mulled blue-berry, incense and fruitcake notes over impressive, graphite-filled grip. Best from 2010 through 2030. From France-JM

**91** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Châteauneuf du Pape 2007* \$45

Fresh and forward, with rounded texture and slightly jammy notes of plum, fig and blackberry fruit laid softly over a mineral streak. Open and juicy through the finish, picking up blueberry and fruitcake hints that balance the forward fruit. Drink now through 2019.- JM

**89** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Châteauneuf du Pape White 2008* \$45

Very fresh, with forward stone fruit flavors backed by hints of nectarine skin and light toast. A touch shy on depth through the finish, but still solid. Drink now. 830 cases made- J.M.



**91** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Côtes du Rhône-Villages Rasteau Les Argiles Bleues 2007* \$38

This is flashy, with dark raspberry and boysenberry fruit liberally laced with incense, fruitcake and melted licorice notes. Nice graphite edge on the finish keeps it all honest. Drink now through 2010.—J.M.

**90** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Côtes du Rhône-Villages Rasteau 2007* \$22

Gorgeous blueberry, blackberry and cherry aromas and flavors ripple through this dense but silky offering. Fruit echoes through the long spice- and graphite-filled finish. Drink now through 2010.—J.M.

**87** **DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD** *Côtes du Rhône 2007* \$15

Juicy and ripe, with a core of crushed cherry and licorice flavors, wrapped with sweet spice notes. Round and fresh. Drink now. 4,165 cases made.-J.M.
