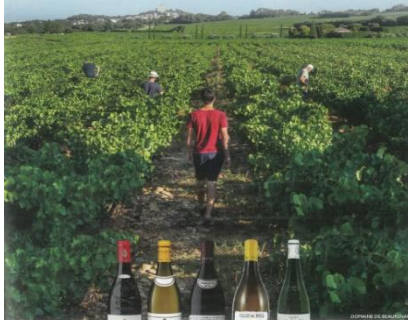

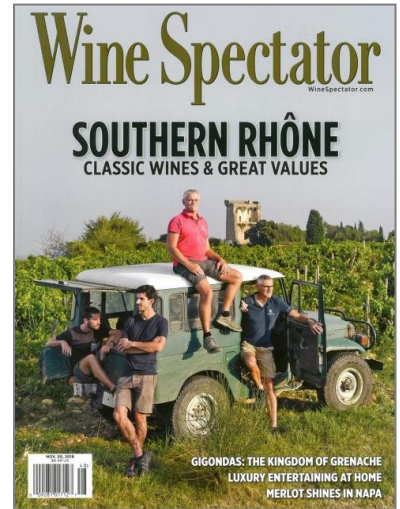

"
